Coaches will pass out keys to lodgers. Keys must be turned in at front desk in Blue Ridge Center or you will be charged \$5.00 for each missing key.

- Guest Services (located in the Blue Ridge Center lobby) hours are from 6:00am-10:00pm, unless otherwise noted. Please let them know of any problems with your sleeping rooms or questions about the facility. You can reach them at (828) 669-8422.
- Security hours are from 8pm 5am. Cell number is (828) 777-1728.
- Complimentary coffee and hot tea served in main Blue Ridge Center lobby from 6:30-8am.
- Recreational activities available: Basketball, Tennis, Volleyball, Geo-caching (need app downloaded on phone), Disc Golf, Cornhole Toss, and hiking. Check out locations and equipment at Guest Services (GS). GS has the keys for the gym, pavilion, and exercise room. Gym times for Basketball gym (#22 on map) and Multi-Purpose gym (#23 on map) are available to NC FPS guests from 7 pm—10 pm Friday and 10 am—12 pm Saturday
- In case of injury a first aid kit and defibrillator are at Guest Services desk. Directions to the nearest hospital and urgent care are available as well. If there is an emergency and you have to call 911, please call Guest Services immediately after. We will meet the first responders at the gate and make sure they get to you quickly.
- Loop road is **one way up, one way down**. Walking is only permitted on the down road. No foot traffic is allowed on the up road.
- Tobacco free campus. Smoking tobacco and/or drug use is not permitted on Assembly property.
- Official NC FPS State Bowl nametags must be worn by all participants (on-campus & commuters) to enter the dining room.
- Candles or incense cannot be burned inside the buildings.
- Bears. Do not confront! Make loud noises and back away. Do not approach or get between mother and cubs. Notify Guest Services desk of location.
- Cabins and Lodges, remember to place trash in the "bear proof" trash bins.
- Please help keep Blue Ridge grounds clean by not littering.
- Park only in designated spaces. Parking in the lots in front of and behind Eureka Hall is allowed for Abbott, Asheville, and Eureka halls. Asheville Hall also has parking on right hand side of lodge and a few roadside spaces at end of Asheville Hall. Cabins have limited parking.
- Loop in front of Eureka Hall is for drop-off only. NO PARKING allowed in the Eureka Hall loop.
- Mountain biking, inline skates and skateboards are prohibited on Blue Ridge property.
